Terms & Conditions

What to expect from Intensio?

- A safe, unconditional and non-judgemental field in every session.
- A mix of going with the flow and moving forward at the same time during the session(s).
- A recording of each session, being sent to you through a 7-day activated WeTransfer link. Once the recording has been downloaded, Intensio will remove the recording from his device unless otherwise approved by the client.
- If the Divine Blueprint is part of the session you book, you will receive a personal PDF-file of it.

What to expect from the client?

- The client is responsible for all results of each session.
- Commitment to themselves, you are the creator of your own experience.
- Discomfort & fear are not to be used as an excuse to not move forward with your process.
- Following the payment, booking & cancellation conditions (see below)

Payment, booking & cancellation

- Payment will be done to Intensio's business account, which is based in the country of Georgia and under the name of Querijn Adriaan Huizer.
- The payment will be a 'World Transfer' to a Georgian IBAN-number: GE22 BG00 0000 0601 9875 55. The client's bank may ask for costs to do a 'World Transfer' and the client can always choose to let these costs be paid by the receiver.
- This means the costs for doing the 'World Transfer' will never increase the cost of the session.
- Booking is done through the website's booking module: <https://www.intensio.io/booking>
- After booking, Intensio will send an invoice to the entered e-mail address, including payment details.
- Payment is done after booking and needs to be received before the session starts. This means the payment needs to be done at least 48 hours before the session starts.
- If the client cancels or reschedules within 24 hours of the session, no refunds can be given.
- If for any reason the client decides to cancel session(s), it is up to Intensio to decide if a refund can be given. However, if a refund is given, the costs for the 'World Transfer' will always be paid by the client. Meaning the amount received by the client is less than what was paid.
